Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I've just returned from the 2025 European Leadership Forum (ELF) in Wisla, Poland, and I want to take a moment to share what's on my heart.

I saw God at work in wonderful ways. Over 850 Christian leaders from across Europe and beyond came together to seek God, to be equipped, and to encourage one another. I serve as an ELF Steering Committee member, Network leader, speaker, and mentor, learning alongside others who, like me, are doing their best to serve the Lord in various contexts.

This was my eleventh time at ELF. I still remember coming to my first ELF—feeling a little tired and wondering if anyone else out there knew what ministry in my part of the world felt like. But ELF was a major encouragement. The Lord led me to people who were walking a similar road and who reminded me that I wasn't alone. God has powerfully used ELF in my life and ministry!

Over the years, I've not only been refreshed, but I've also been given the chance to pour into others. Through mentoring relationships, conversations over coffee, and shared moments of prayer, I've watched younger leaders gain clarity and confidence. It's humbling and beautiful.

The best part is that what happens at ELF doesn't stay in Wisla. I've taken what I've learned from talks, sermons, books, and even stories and brought these insights back home. I've used them in my own sermons. I've shared them with fellow pastors and church members. I've watched them open doors for Gospel conversations in places where doors have been closed for a long time. ELF is truly a catalyst, not just for me, but for the entire European Church.

Leaders from across the continent are doing the same—they are taking the resources they've been equipped with at ELF to their contexts, and they are spreading the Gospel throughout Europe. They are using ELF resources all year round!

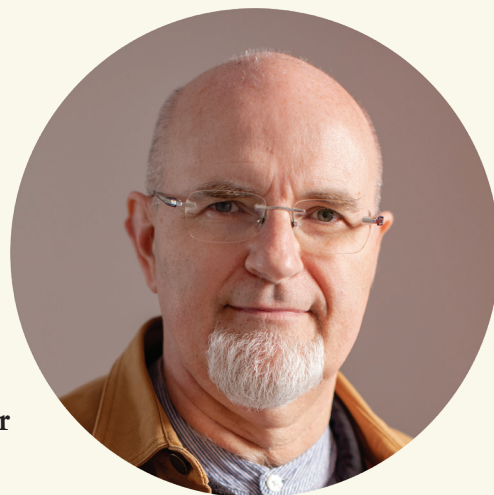

The Forum's Annual Meeting

This May, over 850 Gospel leaders gathered once again in Wisla, Poland, for the 23rd European Leadership Forum (ELF) Annual Meeting. Representing 53 countries, these leaders came from across Europe and beyond—each carrying the joys and challenges of ministry in their unique contexts. Some arrived tired, others sought new connections with believers, but all came to praise God and ask Him to work in their lives and ministries.

God was faithful. Through 31 Networks and over 100 ELF leaders and mentors, God poured out His love, wisdom, and encouragement. Leaders learned better how to serve the Lord in their ministries upon their return home, new connections were formed, and conversations turned into new year-round collaborations that will see a multiplication of fruit.

We praise God for how He moved mightily through the 2025 Forum Annual Meeting. God used ELF to equip His servants not only with knowledge and resources, but with new encouragement to proclaim the Gospel to Europe. We thank Him for doing far more than we could on our own and sending these Gospel leaders back to their home countries ready to spread His Kingdom.

...from Acorns to Oak Trees

God is transforming the lives and ministries of Gospel leaders across Europe through the European Leadership Forum (ELF). Using the image of giant oak trees with far-reaching branches growing from small acorns, ELF identifies, equips, unites, and resources Gospel leaders (“acorns”) to help them grow into spiritually mature Christian leaders (“oak trees”) who have far-reaching impacts for His Kingdom in their own contexts.



Many leaders first arrive at the European Leadership Forum Annual Meeting



during seasons of doubt, exhaustion, or isolation. Others are seeking answers to their questions in ministry and mentors who can guide and train them to become more fruitful. Through biblically-centered teaching and Gospel-oriented relationships, they leave the Forum Annual Meeting equipped and refreshed to take on further leadership roles when they return home. They continue to be resourced and encouraged in their ministries through the Forum’s year-round initiatives.

The European Leadership Forum serves as a greenhouse, cultivating these Gospel leaders on their path to maturity so that by God’s grace and power, they can make Kingdom impacts far beyond ELF’s Annual Meeting or year-round initiatives. God is producing ripple effects through these leaders’ apologetics, discipleship, church planting, national gatherings, and more for His glory.



As Forum leaders love and pour into Gospel leaders through Christ-centered Plenary and Network sessions, Workshops, and Mentoring meetings, God is turning spiritual “acorns” into mature, Gospel-sharing “oak trees.” In this way, He is using the European Leadership Forum for His glory and expanding His Kingdom across Europe and beyond.

What is the Fruit of the Forum?

A Life Changed by the Forum



Over a decade ago, a young youth leader from Slovakia named Ján Máhrik made his way to the European Leadership Forum.

What drew him to ELF wasn't a flashy program or the chance to listen to a well-known speaker—it was the personal testimonies and encouragement from his father and wife, who had both previously attended the Forum.

While a master's student in IT, Ján worked as a part-time youth pastor and developed a national youth ministry on the side. He was full of questions about ministry and was eager to attend ELF.



“That first ELF was exciting! I was hungry for information. I joined every single session I could! I went to Pre-Forum and Post-Forum Seminars, I went to all the Workshops, everything!”

Ján experienced a week packed with seminars, lectures, books, and inspiring Christian leaders from across Europe. Ján dove in and absorbed as much as he could. “I was happy, fulfilled, and overwhelmed,” he says, and ELF left a lasting impression. “That was a great time,” he recalls, “but it takes at least two to three years to realize how to use the Forum.”

Over the next few years, as Ján continued to attend ELF, his life and ministry began to change. While continuing to work in youth ministry and starting his own IT business, he felt the calling to plant a new church. This transition took a toll on him personally and in ministry as he added more and more to his plate. He had a young family, and he was working overtime to fit everything together.

That year, as Ján travelled to ELF, close to burnout, he prayed for God to provide him with a mentor who could shepherd him through his difficult transition; God's answer came swiftly.

“I was eating lunch alone at a table, and some guy approached me,” Ján recalls. That man was Forum speaker Ed Doepel, who said to Ján, “I was praying to God that He would show me whom I could talk to and invest in, and God showed me you.”

Ed sat down with Ján, and they ate lunch together, kept talking through the afternoon sessions, and met together for evening coffee. Throughout the day, Ján shared about his family and ministry. Ed listened and, in the evening, gave a direct piece of advice: If Ján didn't make adjustments to his way of working, he would lose everything. Ján took Ed's advice seriously and made changes to his life, adding with a smile, "My wife is very thankful."

Ján and Ed have since built a wonderful friendship. Not only did Ed help mentor Ján through this difficult situation, but Ed also happened to have planted several churches.

As the years went by, Ed introduced Ján to others with biblical wisdom and practical experience, and Ján continued to lean on Ed's advice for his own church plant, which officially opened in 2016. "That was very encouraging, and the friendship lasts until today," Ján relays. "That's one of the relationships that was providential, thanks to ELF."



This kind of long-term investment is what Ján now tries to implement as he gives back. In recent years, he has returned to ELF not only as a participant but as a mentor and the teacher of multiple ELF sessions, because, as he puts it, "I gained a lot, so I have to give a lot."

Today, Ján is a church planter, author, and award-winning podcaster, reaching thousands across both Slovakia and the Czech Republic through online ministry. He sees ELF as a crucial support system—especially in his context.

"Ministry is tough, always. Churches in Slovakia, and in Eastern and Central Europe, are under-resourced, under-funded, under-staffed, and we always pray that God will provide. ELF is definitely a way of God's provision."

Ján is now entering another new season—increased involvement with ELF and also stepping into a leadership position on his denomination's national board. Ján epitomizes ELF's strategy of identifying high-impact Gospel leaders and uniting, equipping, and resourcing them.

"I've been equipped, encouraged, and resourced by ELF. It's not always about material resources; it's also about having encouragement, know-how, and networking."



A curious young man, full of questions, has grown into a leader who not only has a significant Gospel impact in his context in Slovakia but who now pours into other European Gospel leaders at ELF, giving to others in the same way that he once received. God is using the Forum to create a Gospel renewal across Europe.

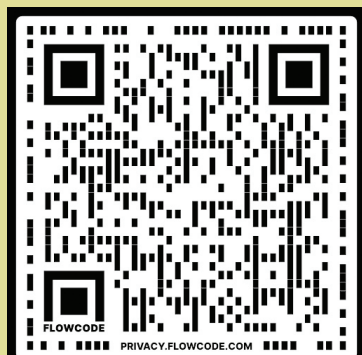
