

## **What is a FOCL Talk?**

### **FOCL Talk Overview**

In a FOCL talk, a Forum speaker presents a concise, clear, 20-minute lecture on a key topic, followed by participant question-and-answer time. The session will be captured by high-definition video utilising multiple cameras.

### **FOCL**

FOCL stands for Forum of Christian Leaders, the name given to the website that hosts content from the Forum as well as webinars given by Forum speakers so that viewers around the world can access them freely.

### **The Details**

The Format will proceed as follows:

- (1) Before the talk begins, the speaker briefly explains the format of the talk to those in attendance:
  - (a) Audience members will refrain from speaking for the duration of the talk
  - (b) Audience members will be able to ask questions at the talk's conclusion
- (2) The speaker delivers his/her talk (20 minutes)
- (3) The speaker answers participants' questions (15-20 minutes)

### **Sessions with multiple FOCL talks**

Many sessions, particularly workshops and Pre- and Post-Forum Seminars, will include multiple FOCL talks. In this scenario, the session will alternate between FOCL lecture and discussion.
