How Did It Go?

After two online Forums in 2020 and 2021, we were all excited to gather in Wisla, Poland for the 2022 European Leadership Forum. Despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine, Evangelical Christian leaders from across Europe and around the world were united, equipped, and resourced.

ELF gave isolated leaders a chance to worship the Lord together and participate in specialized training, mentoring, resource sharing, and networking. These key Gospel leaders left the Forum equipped and energized for a new year of ministry, and we couldn't have done it without your generous support. **Thank you!**

- 1 Almost 600 participants from 41 countries attended the Forum. Nearly 200 of these hand-picked leaders were scholarship recipients from Eastern, Central, or Southern Europe. Thanks to you, all the leaders who needed scholarships to be equipped and resourced at ELF received one!
- In addition to leaders from Europe, we also expanded our **Forum Global strategy** for leaders from around the world. Gospel leaders attended ELF from countries like Kenya, Pakistan, Egypt, Korea, Philippines and Ghana. These global leaders came to ELF because they want to learn the Forum strategies and duplicate them in their own countries. Ministry leaders in Ghana, for example, after attending ELF in the past, launched the Ghana Forum, which held its second annual meeting in the fall of 2021. Just one example of the ripple impacts of this year's ELF is that **African Gospel leaders attending ELF decided to launch a Forum-like conference for all of Africa in 2023!**
- ELF participants learned in 25 Forum Networks designed to mentor and resource leaders in specific ministry and vocational callings.

 Different Networks focused on such diverse areas as youth ministry,



apologetics, church planning and revitalization, leadership, discipleship, science, fundraising, counseling, evangelism, and more. Participants found these Networks encouraging, strategic, and helpful. In just one example, participants rated the Organisational Development and Fundraising Network a full 5 out of 5 in overall satisfaction. Gospel leaders loved having the chance to be trained by Christian experts and encouraged through fellowships with their peers.

- 4 Spiritually mature Forum speakers led over 300 individual Sessions and Workshops.

 These speakers are leading experts on various discipleship, evangelistic, leadership, and biblical topics. They are doing incredible work for God's Kingdom across Europe and around the world. The opportunity for speakers to share their knowledge and best practices is one of the greatest blessings the Forum offers.
- This year we were excited for the first time to successfully livestream our plenary sessions through our YouTube channel and website. Throughout the week, **up to 1,000 online viewers** participated virtually in our morning and evening plenary sessions.
- We also hosted the **Forum Expo**, where **21 exhibitors from Christian ministries and organizations** connected with leaders, shared their visions, and offered resources

- and opportunities for leaders to get involved. The Expo provided a clearinghouse for participants to meet people from outside their Network, across Europe, and around the world and to make new connections for future partnership.
- More than **2,800 excellent books** were distributed to Forum participants at the **Forum Bookstore**, where leaders received a 60 to 80% discount off retail. Forum volunteers reported seeing tears in participants' eyes as they realized the number of books they could purchase at such discounted prices!
- Participants built relationships in 197 oneon-one mentoring sessions. Throughout the 2020-2021 season, our 21 Year-Round Mentoring initiatives involved more than 150 participants. There will be 25 Year-Round Mentoring strategies in 2022-2023, and registration is still ongoing through September.
- 9 All participants were invited to **submit prayer requests** to the Forum prayer team.
 These requests were brought before the
 Lord multiple times during the week.
 At least twice a day all leaders also came
 together to pray with their fellow leaders.








What are Others Saying?



JONATHAN BOND of the Fellowship of Independent Evangelical Churches published an article from his UK perspective on his experience at the Forum. He writes:





SARAH BREUEL is the Director of Revive Europe, a ministry that seeks to unite students in Mission and to pursue a move of God in the student generation in Europe. Sarah announced at ELF that Revive would become its own organization at the end of 2022. Already over 1,500 students from 90 nations have registered to attend their end-of-year conference. Sarah shared:



"Our dry continent needs fresh streams of water. We can't simply strategize our way over the re-evangelization of Europe, as important as strategies are. We need a fresh outpouring of the Spirit of Jesus to turn the tide for the gospel in our continent... We stand together as we long for God to do something much larger than any organisation. We would love your prayers for God's breath as we try as best to build this 'ark' and we trust God for the rain."



CHARLES KELLEY, leader of the Artists Network, shared his thoughts in an article on the importance of the Artists Network for promoting connection and faith:



"Artists need encouragement, and this is my number one goal. You need to recognize that your talent is from God, and God gives both talent and responsibility. We want people to get the opportunity to inspire each other and to ask the question: What can we do together that we cannot do alone?"

God has used ELF to **encourage** and **inspire** leaders to work **together** for the Gospel in **new** and **powerful ways**.
