This was my 21st Forum – and I look forward to it every time! ELF is unique in many respects: the quality of the teaching with biblical and theological depth combined with serious engagement with current European culture, the sharp strategic thinking, the emphasis on relationships and cooperation, and the reliance on the work of God.

I returned home refreshed and inspired, having heard so many encouraging stories and witnessed God actively working through many Gospel leaders. It was such a joy to serve at ELF again this year. I cannot think of a more important meeting place for Evangelical leaders in Europe than ELF.

Europe is in desperate need of knowledgeable, well-equipped, and courageous Gospel leaders. So, it has been amazing to see how the spread of the Gospel in Europe has been reignited through ELF. I marvel when I think of the wave of church planting that has taken place in Europe during the last two decades. I rejoice when I see the fruits of the year-round mentoring and training programs. The Details

Over 700 participants from 52 countries attended ELF. 286 Evangelical leaders received scholarships so they could be united with peers and mentors, and be equipped, encouraged, and resourced. Thank you for supporting their ministry!

Each Gospel leader chose a specialized leadership Network, to be trained and equipped. Forum Networks specialize in evangelism, media communication, science, theology, art, and more! We had 24 Networks and 250 Network sessions.

We were grateful to have 115 gifted and fruitful Evangelical leaders give their time, talent, and treasure to lead 360 Network sessions, workshops, and seminars. We had an additional 34 leaders come to ELF to mentor Gospel leaders. Every leader makes significant sacrifices to serve at ELF, yet most of the Forum speakers and mentors return to ELF every year because they share the burden and passion to better equip ministry leaders in Europe.

Our bookstore is often one of the greatest highlights of the Forum. The total value of this year's books was \$67,773, and the cost to leaders was only \$12,882. Many participants brought along extra luggage just so they could stock up on these affordable, valuable resources that they wouldn't have access to apart from ELF.

We maintained an online presence throughout this year's ELF. Each plenary session was live-streamed so that over **4,000 viewers from 12 different countries** were trained and equipped by ELF sessions!

The Forum Expo is another highlight for participants to connect. We had 22 Exhibitors from Christian ministries and organizations who networked with leaders by offering best practices and opportunities for them to get involved and gain additional resources. Scores of connections came from Gospel leaders meeting other leaders doing the same thing in different places, being eager to learn from each other.

Many participants loved participating in personal mentoring sessions over the past year. During the year, there were 23 Year-Round Mentoring Initiatives with 111 participants. During the Forum, there were 241 one-on-one mentoring sessions organized by the ELF team and hundreds of relationships that God organized!

THE SPEAKERS

This year we were so thankful to offer the teaching of 115 gifted and fruitful ministry leaders. It was a particular delight to experience the teaching of Conrad Mbewe (Founding Chancellor, African Christian University) at every morning plenary session. Over four days, he unpacked the theme of God's faithfulness throughout the book of Malachi. His teaching was rich and beneficial to so many leaders!

During Conrad's teaching, Balazs Koncsard (a worship leader and theology student in Hungary) had a powerful encounter with the Lord:

"It is my first time attending the European Leadership Forum in person, and I can honestly say that it is a huge refreshment in my calling. I'm writing this shortly after I had

a deep encounter with God in the morning plenary session. I had bitterness towards God in my heart that I didn't even realize because I felt like he abandoned me while I was doing his work. The message this morning brought this issue to the surface, and I finally saw the true character of God in my life. He is with me, He has not abandoned me; instead, He is refining me in fire. I needed this so much."

Our evening plenary sessions were led by several other gifted leaders: Michael Reeves (*President, Union School of Theology*), Julia Garschagen (*Director, Pontes Institute for Science, Culture, and Faith*), Luke Greenwood (*Director, Steiger*), and Lindsay Brown (*Director, Fellowship of Evangelists in the Universities of Europe*).





Luke Greenwood shares why he continues to invest in ELF:

"ELF 2023 was a great
encouragement and
investment! It was great to see
many new people, especially

many younger leaders now attending and being invested in. There was also important space given to younger leaders in the speaking and workshops, bringing a fresh voice into the Forum. We come each year, with a select group from our mission which is a good way to keep developing our people. ELF is a key place for training, networking, and hearing what God is doing around Europe.



THE VOLUNTEERS

We had generous support from 84 volunteers. 61 were from the United States and 23 were from Europe. Many have been faithfully serving at the Forum for years, and this was the first time for others! We were so grateful for their help.

This was Ryan Heath's 2nd Forum. He is a pastor at Scottsdale Bible Church, and he offers his pastoral care to the ELF volunteers during the Forum. He reflects:

"I really enjoyed my time serving at ELF again this year! As far as the importance of ELF, as you sit in the plenary session and hear the Word taught so passionately

and accurately to a room full of key pastoral leaders from 52 different countries, I can't imagine a higher impact room for the Gospel! Many of these pastors come from areas where there is very little support and I love the respite and encouragement they experience at ELF. Then when you add in the year-round mentoring and network aspect of the support, the ministry impact grows and compounds throughout the year. Each of those pastors and ministry leaders in the room represents exponentially more individuals than just themselves, as they lead their own ministries back at home. ELF is a very high-impact strategy, and I thank God it exists."

THE PARTICIPANTS

All of our participants know that ELF is much more than a one-week event; it is a relationally, emotionally, and spiritually transformative movement.

Noah Johnson is a church planter in Slovakia. He attests to renewal that occurs at the Forum:

"I came into the Forum with hurt and was a little disillusioned about continuing in ministry. Through the encouragement of new friends, the prayers of fellow ministers, and new connections through networking, the Lord has answered my questions. I am now returning home with a fresh vision and energy to continue on in the calling God has placed on my heart."

Andreea Bojoga, a physician and member of the Christian Medical Association of Romania, shares why the Forum is transformative:

"The experience of being at the ELF is transforming not only at a personal level, as I can see Him and the Gospel more powerfully and beautifully than before, but

also refreshes my vision for the ministry I am involved in, better equips me in our Christian calling of sharing the Gospel - especially how relevant, consistent, and coherent it is for our challenges nowadays. . . I strongly believe this experience is transforming and as many Christians as possible should attend and multiply what they've received here in their personal context - for a revival across Europe and the whole world."

EQUIPPING A LEADER IN SLOVENIA


Two million people live in Slovenia. Like the vast majority of Europe, Slovenia is rapidly growing in secularization, and most Slovenians identify as agnostic or atheist. Sadly, there are only about 2,000 Evangelical Christians in the entire country, which is roughly 1 believer for every 1,000 Slovenians. Fortunately, God is not done with Slovenia, and He is working through our ELF leaders!

Anja Kranjc is 1 of 8 Evangelical leaders from Slovenia who were trained and equipped at ELF this year. This was Anja's second year being trained at ELF. Anja works as a professional psychologist and serves as a youth ministry leader. She may work in a non-Christian environment but she stays firmly rooted in her Christian convictions. Her mission is to use biblical principles to help non-Christian people with mental problems and disorders. However, this is challenging in practice - she often faces the dilemma of how she can actually use biblical principles in a non-Christian environment.

This is where ELF came in. Through your support, we were able to provide Anja with a scholarship so she could participate in the Forum and receive the resources, connections, and mentorship she needed. After last year's Forum, she shared:

"I have learned a lot of new things at the Forum, especially when helping people with their problems in the church. For example, now I understand emotions from a Christian perspective and about how Jesus sees our feelings, not just in a typical psychological way."

Last year was so valuable to her ministry and she was so eager to return and build on what she learned!









This year she participated in the Professional Counsellors Network, as well as remaining involved in Year-Round Mentoring. She expressed her deepest thanks to God, her mentor, and to you! Due to your generosity, she is able to reflect:

"ELF has been a huge help for me - actually, it was life-changing for me to join the Forum. I really feel so blessed. It is such a gift for me because I always get so much from it - a blessing, guidance, new ideas, and a clearer vision from God. ... Being a part of ELF also encourages me to grow in my relationship with the Lord because all of the leaders are such amazing examples of people who trust in our God 100% and serve him with all they are!... I am so thankful to God for all of you and for my wonderful mentor and I feel so privileged to be a part of ELF."

After this year's ELF, Anja went home freshly resourced and inspired to faithfully continue on in her ministry as a light in the darkness in Slovenia.


